The organization has been registered as a Non Governmental Organization under the Non Governmental Organization Act. No. 24 of 2002 as amended from time to time. Its head office is at Kasulu, Kigoma, Tanzania and field office at Ngarantoni, Selian Lutheran Hospital, Arusha, Tanzania. Its registration number is ooNGO/R/5207. **Our main focus is serving life threatened kids with curable disabilities.**

The month of **August**, 2024 went very well with major achievements for the work of the organization. During this month we implement the major following tasks.

- **Attended all the key organization meetings** of Child review meetings, Child Surgeries Tanzania Board meetings and Biashara Afrika training. **We didn't had Donor meetings.**

During this month I visited KASULU ORPHANAGE HOPE CENTER. This is the orphanage center based in Kasulu town whereby they also host kids with disabilities. Apart from visiting I had a screen of two kids with bowlegs. These two kids are standard seven and will be going to Selian Lutheran Hospital on November after finishing their final exams.

During this month I had an opportunity to represent CST to the Kasulu District Commissioner and other NGOs dealing with Children's protection. Currently children have been lost all over Tanzania. But also making aware of the issue and how to go about so as not to be in trouble.

- Maggie is very committed to supervise Elizabeth and Caroline. These mothers are taking well their responsibilities.
- I normally receive the daily updates of each kids from the team members.
- However our team work is very strong whereby Macha and Lightness they are very close to keep watching the kids as well.
- Kids are being feed well with proper r meals on time.
- Kids are being seen by doctors during their daily routines. This also helps to keep our kids safe from any emergencies.
- The kids are very health, their parents are witness when they come to pick them.

Challenges:

During this month we had a slightly delaying of the referral for **Asante** to KCMC due to the fact that we had to wait her grandmother from Kigoma to Arusha to take care her at KCMC.
